C.A.R.E.S.™ Leadership Lesson Format (Final Version)

Letter	Final Title	Purpose
C	Connect	A short, intentional prompt from the teacher to connect students to the theme, the moment, or each other. This could be a quote, story, image, question, or visual check-in. It sets the tone.
A	Activate	A quick entry task to activate thinking and reflection. This engages students individually through journaling, a scenario response, or creative thinking tied to the weekly theme.

R	Relate	A connection activity where students interact with one another — peer discussions, empathy circles, team challenges, or collaboration tasks that build trust and belonging.
E	Empower	The leadership lesson + challenge that delivers core content. This is where students learn a key concept, strategy, or behavior and are challenged to apply it in school or life.
S	Seal	A final reflective wrap-up that allows students to summarize learning, share an insight, set an intention, or close with gratitude. “What will I take with me today?”
